Year 11 - Mr Smith *Year 11 have almost completed their full 5 years at Dean Trust Ardwick!*



UNICEF: Rights Respecting Schools

Article 2, 8 and 30 UN Convention on the Rights of the Child.

This week's articles of the week are Article 2, 8 and 30.

Article 2 – Non-discrimination


The Convention applies to every child without discrimination, whatever their ethnicity, gender, religion, language, abilities or any other status, whatever they think or say, whatever their family background.

Article 8 – Protection and preservation of identity

Every child has the right to an identity. Governments must respect and protect that right, and prevent the child's name, nationality or family relationships from being changed unlawfully.

Article 30 – Children from minority or indigenous groups

Every child has the right to learn and use the language, customs and religion of their family whether or not these are shared by the majority of the people in the country where they live.

Oxford University Virtual Tour

Our pupils showed a lots of interest in the prestigious Oxford University.

Owing to the restrictions of the pandemic, Year 10 pupils were not able to physically visit Oxford University as in previous years. However, by using our connections with this prestigious university, over seventy Year 10 pupils were able to take a virtual tour of Corpus Christi College at Oxford. The huge amount of interest amongst the year group showed the high-level of ambition and the desire amongst pupils to research their options for the future.

During the tour, pupils were shown some of the landmarks and made aware of the many opportunities that university-life could bring. Furthermore, pupils were able to engage with an outreach officer from the university who was able to provide further details and also answer questions in an interactive session. It is hoped that several more events like this, and even actual visits to seats of learning, could soon take place.

Year 9 study static electricity!




Incredible talent from our Key Stage 4 pupils!



IMPORTANT EXAMS INFORMATION

End of Year Exams for all pupils

Next half term, all pupils will be sitting end of year exams. For all year groups, formal examinations are important to ensure that the school have accurate attainment and progress data from which to effectively plan schemes of future learning. For pupils specifically, formal examinations throughout school life help to build habits for exam success, the discipline and organisation required to follow exam procedures, as well as the resilience to perform at their highest level.

Key Stage 3 Examinations

At Key Stage 3, exams in English, maths and science (core subjects) will be taking place under formal examination conditions in the exam hall. Within other subjects, exams will be during timetabled lessons in classrooms. For all exams, we will ensure pupils who may qualify for access arrangements are provided with these.

We urge you to support us in ensuring pupils are ready for examinations by having full attendance and bringing their Dean Trust Ardwick clear pencil case and equipment with them each day (as expected). Year 9 pupils will be given a candidate timetable which informs of the room and their individual seat number for each exam. Pupils must make sure they keep this timetable and can refer to it each day for where they are sitting in each exam.

Year 10 Mock Examinations

Our Year 10s will be sitting a full set of mock exams in all GCSE and vocational subjects. Pupils must strictly adhere to all JCQ procedures and rules throughout each examination and must ensure they keep their candidate timetable with them so that they know their seat number and room for each exam. 100% attendance at these exams is vital. Having not had the opportunity for formal examinations earlier this year, or at the end of last academic year, these exams are an important milestone in preparing for the terminal exams at the end of Year 11.
