Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your ongoing support and patience during this period. I acknowledge that the uncertainty surrounding the full reopening of the school has been a source of frustration for many, and I appreciate your understanding.

Following the announcement that we are progressing to Phase 2 of our gradual reopening week commencing January 29, 2024. I am pleased to confirm, we will be welcoming back a second year group on Wednesday 31st January 2024.

We are delighted to announce our intention to bring Year 9 back on site on Wednesday 7th February 2024. However, it's essential to be aware that these plans and timelines remain subject to change. Our commitment is to keep you well-informed and engaged throughout the phased reopening process. To ensure clarity, we will communicate with parents 48 hours in advance to confirm that Year 9 will be returning on this date.

- Pupils should arrive at school as normal via the side gate- before 8.36am.
- On arrival, pupils should go to their normal Form Rooms for Form Time.
- We expect all pupils to arrive at school Ready to Learn: in full school uniform, wearing school shoes, not wearing make-up, lashes or false nails, and bringing their equipment.
- Pupils must continue to complete their remote learning each day until their return to school.

I want to reassure you that specialist cleaning has been completed, and that the school has obtained a certificate from trained professionals confirming that the school premises is safe for occupancy.

It is our core purpose as a school to ensure all pupils find their purpose and thrive as citizens of the world. The Year 9 options process is a crucial milestone on this journey as we support them, collaboratively with yourselves, to move into Key Stage 4 on an ambitious and appropriate pathway towards their futures. Despite the current circumstances, we want to support you and your child to be able to make the most informed choices.
